**Explanations / Teacher's Notes:**

- **Q4:** 3 Hundreds (300) + 2 Tens (20) + 4 Ones (4) = 324.
- **Q26:** 560 can be formed as 500 + 60, or 56 tens ( $56 \times 10 = 560$ ), or 500 + 50 + 10.
- **Q38:** 3 Hundreds = 300; 14 Ones = 14.  $300 + 14 = 314$ .
- **Q48:** 2 Hundreds = 200; 15 Tens = 150.  $200 + 150 = 350$ .
